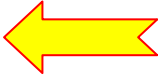

Why you should attend!

This two-day program is designed for those who respond to or have oversight responsibility for incidents cause by terrorism, natural disaster, major accidents, and all other hazards. The training enhances the basic "Threat & Risk Assessment" course (MGT-310) by teaching participants how to apply all phases of the DHS and FEMA risk management process to jurisdictional critical infrastructure and key resources.

Through classroom instruction and practical exercises, students will learn: methods to identify and prioritize risks from all hazards; assess vulnerabilities; estimate consequences; and how to use equipment, training and exercises to mitigate risk. Multidisciplinary student teams will visit and assess local facilities to determine risks, vulnerabilities, consequences and mitigation options specific to their assigned site. Teams then document their findings using a software assessment tool, develop an action plan, and present their results to the class.
